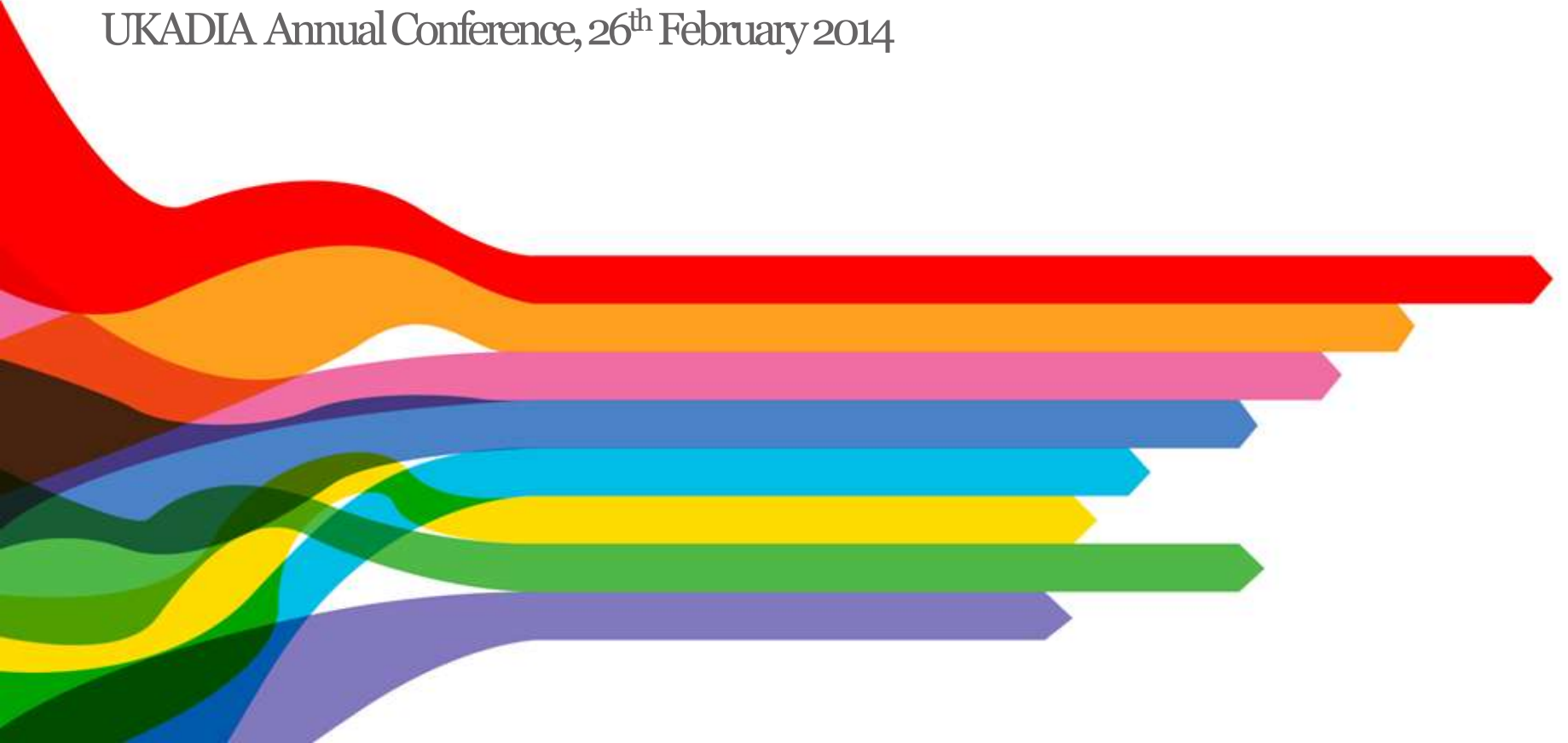

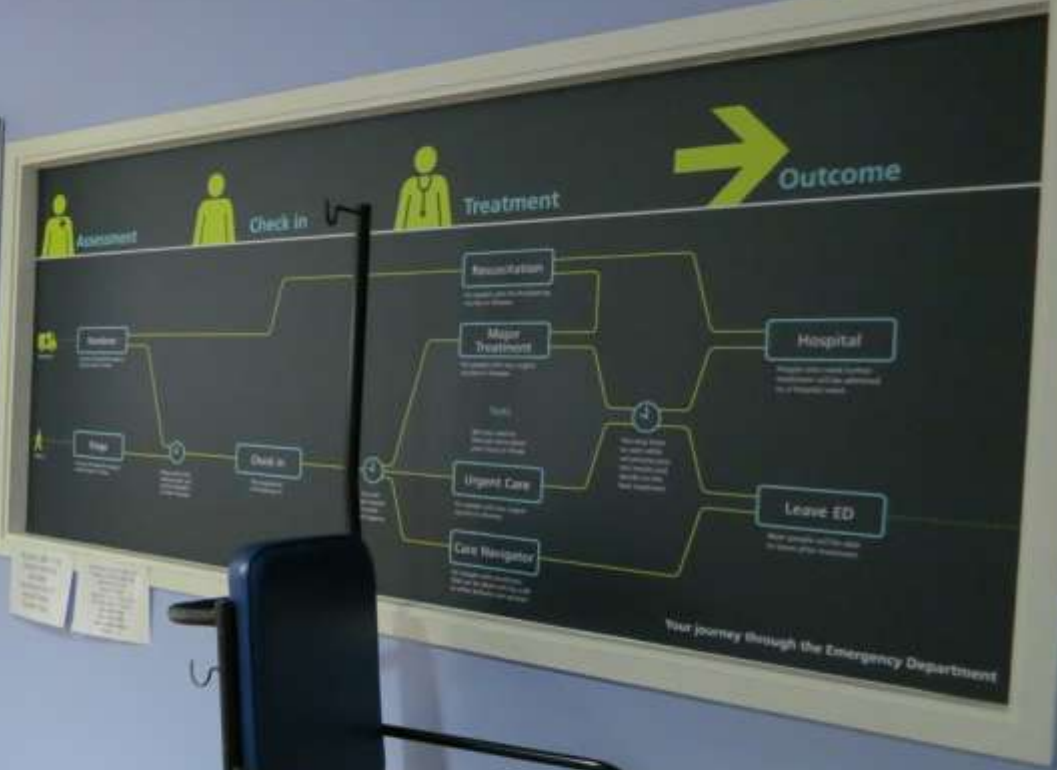
Arrivals

Please wait here. You need to speak to a triage nurse. All patients will have their injuries or illnesses assessed by the nurse.

- 1. Triage nurse will assess your condition and prioritise you for treatment.
- 2. You will be taken to the appropriate treatment area.
- 3. You will be seen by a doctor or nurse.
- 4. You will be treated and then either discharged or admitted to hospital.

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Pathways to Design : Young People's Entry to the Design Sector



Creative & Cultural Skills, November 2013

Pathways to Design examines the design industry's perceptions of young people, their suitability for work and the necessary skills and abilities needed to thrive within the sector. It is the first major quantitative study of design employer views on the education sector in the UK.

Pathways to Design

- 76% of design employers were happiest to employ graduates
- 58% felt that those graduates did not come with the skills they expected, citing:
 - Commercial awareness
 - Communication skills
 - Basic business & workplace skills

Pathways to Design

However...

- only 14% could claim to be 'very engaged' with education
- 25% felt that it wasn't their responsibility to engage
